Shaivism and Advaita Vedanta

Nishanth Selvalingam was initiated into Shaiva Tantra by his grandfather in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. His grandfather was a realized practitioner of the tradition who spent his days in prayer and contemplation in an ashram next to Nishanth's house; most of his education in Shaiva Tantra was from the example of his grandfather.

In 2016, Nishanth moved to Los Angeles to study philosophy and play guitar in a rock band. When his grandfather left the body in 2020, Nishanth started teaching Tantra to spread the empowering message of the tradition. Currently, he creates content on TikTok, Instagram and YouTube and holds classes four times a week in person and online on all things Non-Duality, Tantra and Yoga in the light of Sri Ramakrishna. He is a disciple of Pujya Swami Sarvadevanandaji, the minister of the Vedanta Society of Southern California.

Everything that he does is merely an offering to the lotus feet of his guru, the embodiment of Sri Ramakrishna.
